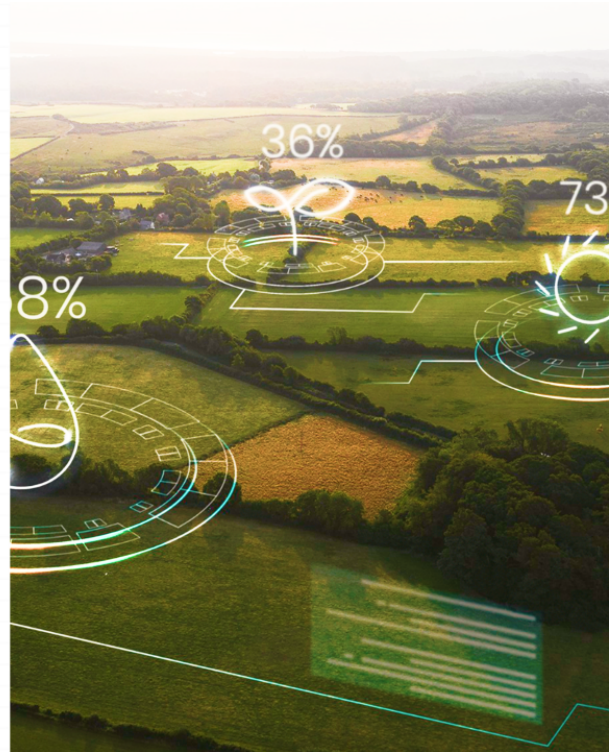




ESG IS NOT JUST COMPLIANCE; IT IS A PERFORMANCE DRIVER
